Course Overview

The questioning techniques course is to enable participants to enhance understanding to apply appropriate strategies to motivate and promote children to ask questions in the classrooms.

The trainer will facilitate the workshop for participants to go through the various steps to teach children 'how' questions. Participants will be provided with a scenario of how a child ask questions to a teacher. There will also be activities planned for discussion and brainstorming before presenting in a skit/role play.
